



AMBASSADOR PROGRAM

- Access to free advanced training and coaching in the implementation of intentional methods (and intentional trauma-informed practice).
- Inter-agency collaboration, networking, peer-to-peer learning and sharing of tools/resources.
- Two-way knowledge exchange with LBI to develop and refine resources and tools, disseminate knowledge and build the capacity of both individuals and communities.
- Collaborate and pool resources with others around shared goals and needs (including through LBI Chapters or Community of Practices).

What is the Ambassador Program?

The Ambassador Program is a key pillar of LBI's community development strategy designed to build individual and collective thriving. This strategy seeks to empower individuals and local communities by activating a network of knowledge, skills and local solutions. This implementation strategy is founded upon three key pillars: (1) Local Empowerment (2) Ambassadors and (3) Chapters (Communities of Practice).

Ambassador Members

Ambassadors are individuals who share LBI's vision for individual

and collective thriving, and work side-by-side with LBI to build local capacity (within their agency and/or community) for interventions and supporting relationships that are underpinned by high awareness and a growth-focused intent. Members are provided access to additional support, advanced training and coaching from LBI, and are supported to network and collaborate with other Ambassadors around shared goals and needs. Ambassadors have a key role to disseminate knowledge, information, tools and resources to empower and build the capacity of their local community.

Member Pre-Requisites

Pre-requisites for Ambassador Membership are as follows:

- Completion of IMPACT Respond Rather Than React (Introduction to Intentional Practice).
- Completion of IMPACT Advanced (Intentional Practitioner) (or commitment to complete within 6 months).
- Commitment to supporting their community (or agency) to design and deliver high quality interventions, programs and supporting adult relationships underpinned by (1) high awareness, (2) intentionality and (3) growth-focused methods.

- Shared values and commitments between LBI and Member (to be formulated in collaboration with LBI and Ambassador Member Group - March 18).

Next Step Entry Point

The Ambassador Program is a pre-requisite for:

- IMPACT Train-The-Trainer.
- Agency and/or individual accreditation pathways.
- A program (agency) or individual's access to a LBI Chapter or Community of Practice.
- LBI committee roles.
