Growing Thriving Capacity At-Scale: Current Initiatives and New Directions

Who is the Forum For?

The forum is designed for both new and existing individuals and agencies. Existing individuals and agencies will learn about broader educational and community development initiatives (and how they can strengthen their work). New individuals and agencies will have the opportunity to learn about the breadth of work and outcomes LBI supports to deliver.

Forum Schedule

- A brief introduction to LBI's vision and method (including intentional practice), accreditation pathways, 2018 community development initiatives and what LBI has learnt in 2018 related to growing capacity in staff and clients at-scale.
- LBI and partner agencies summarising current initiatives and outcomes:
 - Whole-of-school (and multi school site) approaches to building wellbeing and learning outcomes.
 - Building sustainable internal capacity for whole-of-site trauma-informed and therapeutic practices.
 - Building wellbeing and resilience skills at-scale.
 - Growing foster carer capacity to respond to children's trauma and developmental needs at-scale.
 - High impact design and implementation of programs (including for youth-at-risk and from disadvantaged backgrounds).
 - High impact moment-to-moment mentoring, case management, support roles, youth work and teaching.
- LBI plans and initiatives for 2019, including inter-agency collaboration and online resources and training.

LBI Foundation is a not-for-profit educational hub dedicated to providing the knowledge, skills resources and network to empower diverse communities to achieve individual and collective thriving. LBI is founded upon the premise that this vision can be achieved through acquired knowledge (training), skills and intentional methods.

This non-prescriptive approach is designed to complement and strengthen existing services and resources. Evidence indicates that this method can build agency and individual capacity at scale (e.g., across schools, agencies, sites and systems) to grow child, youth and adult capacity for whole-of-life outcomes.
